Saitama City has relatively few disasters. However, we don't know when the next disaster will strike, whether it be a major earthquake, flash flooding, or a missile launch by North Korea. For this reason, Saitama City has emergency broadcast towers set up at 572 locations throughout the city. Prepare yourself for an emergency by getting to know the types of announcements these towers make.

*Sometimes it is difficult to hear the announcements clearly.

~ Saitama City has three major types of announcements.~

① J-Alert: Danger Level★★★★ (more ★s = higher danger)

(Alert comes with a siren sound that differs from police or ambulance sirens, and induces a sense of urgency)

Announcements give information on:

- oBallistic missile launches
- Major terrorist events
- oMajor earthquakes (early warning)
- oExtreme weather



② Emergency Broadcast: Danger Level★★★

Warns/Informs about:

- ∘Heat stroke
- Photochemical smog
- oBank transfer fraud
- Lost children or elderly people(w/ request to find them)



③ General (Daily) Announcement: Danger Level 0 (Testing for broadcast types ① and ②)



Request to protect/watch over children oevening time announcement (at 5pm April-September and 4pm October-March)



Sometimes it's hard to understand what the broadcast is saying. In that case, try asking someone in your neighborhood what it's about. This also helps make for good communication between neighbors!
